Access Times

Access to the Council cemetery is available for the purposes of site inspection and measuring up during the designated opening hours of the cemetery.

Hours of Work

Masonry work may only be carried out between the hours of 7.30 am and 5.00 pm on normal working days of the week. Work cannot be carried out on Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays.

Restrictions on Works

Masonry work is not to be carried out within 200 metres of a funeral service that is in progress or as designated by the Cemetery Authority. The Mason or the Mason's Authorised Representative is to coordinate with the Cemetery Authority's nominated representative on the appropriate date and time for the works, to ensure minimal conflict with funeral services and maintenance work.

Concrete kerbs and surrounds

These are not permitted in any general lawn sections of Councils Cemeteries.

Vehicular Movements

Vehicles used in the performance of the masonry works are not to be parked so as to obstruct the movement of a cortege, hearse or vehicles used by the deceased person's immediate family during the conduct of a funeral service.

Conduct of the Works Site

The Mason or the Mason's Authorised Representative is responsible for carrying out the works in a tradesman-like manner and for the environmental protection and tidiness of the site during and on completion of the works. This includes the use of soil barriers to prevent disturbed soil from being washed away from the site into receiving waters and for the prevention of any wind-blown litter arising from the works or from building material packaging.

Notifications

The Mason or the Mason's Authorised Representative is to notify the Cemetery Authority's nominated representative 24 hours prior to the pouring of footings and on completion of the works.

Execution of the Works

Masonry work is to be carried out in accordance with:

- The approved plan
- Australian Standard for Monuments and Headstones in Cemeteries
- Current Wyong Shire Council Requirements to Carry out Monumental Work
