

PLAQUE INFORMATION

Noraville Memorial Niche Gardens and Memorial Niche Wall

Who orders the plaques for the Memorial Niche Gardens and Wall? Council orders all plaques. To place ashes in a pre-purchased niche/place or for immediate placement, a *Memorial Niche Gardens or Niche Wall - Plaque Order Form* attached to the *Application for Burial Permit – Placement of Ashes* is required to be completed, showing desired layout and wording for the plaque. The applicant will be asked to confirm the requested layout and wording for the plaque prior to it being ordered. A plaque can take up to 6 weeks to be made. Once the plaque is received by Council, the family will be advised. Additional plaques can be ordered for an extra cost.

How many lines of text can be included on a plaque? A maximum of Ten (10) lines of text, with a maximum of 30 characters including spaces is recommended.

What are the times Council places the ashes and plaques? When the family is ready to place the ashes, they contact Council to have the ashes placed. Council places ashes at an arranged time (every 1st and 3rd Wednesday of each month). Please note that Council does not hold ashes within its offices.

Are there Reserved Plaques? If ashes are not going to be placed in the niche in the near future, a “Reserved” plaque can be affixed by Council, at the request of the Grantee.

PLAQUE INSCRIPTIONS

It is the families' choice for the details included on the inscription. Examples of what you may choose for your inscription include;

- Full Name or Nickname of Deceased
- Date of Birth and Date of Death
- Relationship of deceased (e.g. Wife/Husband/Mother/Father/Grandmother/Grandfather/Sister/Brother/Daughter/Son)
- Phrase of remembrance
